The following breakdown outlines the support structure and NDIS line items used to facilitate the week-long therapeutic and educational **Ubud Family Experience** in Bali, designed for NDIS participants aged 5–14.

Participants are accompanied by their legal guardian or authorised caregiver from commencement of return travel between Australia and Bali, Indonesia. Throughout the program, families will reside together in safe, pre-arranged group accommodation alongside other attending families. **Please note:** Wheelchairs and children with significant mobility challenges will not be suited to attend due to the terrain and physical nature of this program.
